One-on-One English Tutoring at the Library



All you need is a Library Card!

To get a library card you need to:

- ***Go to a library in Regina***
- ***Bring 2 pieces of ID***
 - 1 with name and address (like a bill or driver's license)*
 - 1 with your name (like a health card or bank card)*
- ***Ask to register with the Literacy Unit***
- ***Ask to sign up for one-on-one tutoring*** (There is a waiting list. It may be some time before you get your own tutor)



**Ask about Group Tutoring (at most libraries)
at different times of the day!**

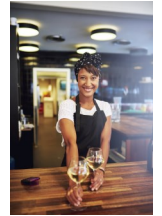

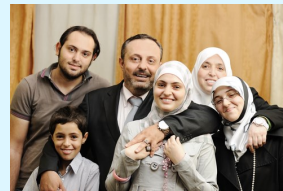

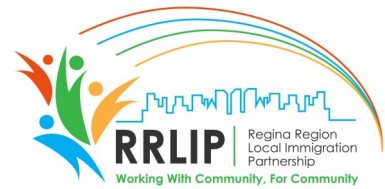

Free English Assessments for LINC Classes - at LARC Regina (for Permanent Residents)



For LINC Classes, students must:

- Be 18 or older
- Be a Permanent Resident (PR includes refugee, family class, etc.)
- Have an official English language assessment done at Language Assessment Referral Centre (LARC) 2445 13th Avenue (Open Monday - Saturday 9am-5pm)
- Make an appointment: 306-525-5272 or larcregina.iws@gmail.com
- Be assessed at levels Literacy to CLB 1-8 on the CLB Placement Test (CLBPT)

Hospital or Emergency Room-ask at the office

- ⇒ Ask for a CanTalk interpreter
- ⇒ Tell operator your language (150 + languages)
- ⇒ Wait for operator to contact an interpreter who speaks your language
- ⇒ Tell interpreter (on phone) what is happening
- ⇒ Listen to answer (on phone)
- ⇒ Follow instructions
