211 Saskatchewan  is a free, confidential, province-wide service that provides information and referrals for local community resources.

Individuals and service providers can access this service every day of the year and at any time of day.

HealthLine 811 is a free, confidential health, mental health and addictions information and support telephone advice service. It is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week to all residents of Saskatchewan.

Services are offered in English, with translation available in over **100 languages**.

HealthLine 811 is staffed by experienced and specially trained Registered Nurses, Registered Psychiatric Nurses and Registered Social Workers.

When you call **HealthLine 811**, a licensed health care professional will **assess** your **physical** and **mental health** concerns, provide care options, support, health information and access to community services.
